Homework

<u>Reading</u>

All children are expected to read everyday at home and this is the main part of their homework. Please comment in the reading diary each time you hear your child read, so that we can congratulate yoour child. Reading is essential to progress so please try to encourage your child, and hear them read as often as possible.

Home Learning

All children are encouraged to complete activities from the home learning grid attached. This is not compulsory however, children will be rewarded for completing a task and have a chance to share it with their peers.

Spellings

In Year 2, we will be sending home key words weekly for the children to learn.

Maths

For a more engaging Maths learning experience, children will have access to Mathletics which is an online programme. Homework will be set once a week for Year 2 children. In Year 1, we encourage the children to explore all activities available to them.

We ask that all children bring in a named water bottle so that they can drink in class. The bottles can be refilled during the day from a main tap if necessary, and staff will do this for the children.

Please could you also ensure that all uniform and PE kit is labelled clearly as most of the children wear the same size in jumpers, trousers, shirts and shoes!
