# Reading

All children are expected to read everyday at home and this is the main part of their homework. Reading is essential to progress so please try to encourage your child, and hear them read as often as possible.

### Home Learning

All children are encouraged to complete activities from the home learning grid attached. This is not compulsory however, children will be given the chance to present their task and share it with their peers.

### Spellings

In Year 2, we will be sending home key words weekly for the children to learn, as well as online spelling practise set one Speling Shed.

#### Maths

For a more engaging Maths learning experience, Year 2 children will have access to Mathletics which is an online programme. Homework will be set once a week for Year 2 children. In Year 1, we encourage the children to explore all activities available to them.

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We ask that all children bring in a named water bottle so that they can drink in class. The bottles can be refilled during the day from a main tap if necessary, and staff will do this for the children.

Please could you also ensure that all uniform and PE kit is labelled clearly as most of the children wear the same size in jumpers, trousers, shirts and shoes!

PE for Year 1 and Year 2 will be on a <u>Monday and Friday</u>, please ensure you send your child in to school wearing the correct PE appropriate for the weather that day.
