Year 4 Homework – Autumn Two 2025

Thank you for your patience and support this year. The class are much more settled now with their new teachers and we are confident the pupils will continue to thrive.

Following this early settling period, we'd like to set clear homework routines for the coming term.

All children in Year 4 should:

Read for 20 minutes **every day** and record this in their reading diaries.
Complete at least 2 maths tasks on LBQ throughout the week
Complete 5/10 minutes of TT rockstars practice every day.

LBQ

Pupils should use their independent log in code to sign in.
There will be multiple tasks available – depending on how many they have completed already.
LBQ will give pupils immediate feedback – research shows this is highly effective for homework, so please encourage your child to read and reflect on this.

TT Rockstars

Pupils will be set their tables accordingly to practice on the programme. It should automatically be able to give them the tables assigned to them! Please also practice 'Soundcheck' regularly, as this imitates the Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) they will complete in June.

In addition, we have included 3 optional activities linked with the rest of the curriculum. We'd like all pupils to do these to enrich their learning in these topics:

Writing - Diary Entry

Keep an ongoing diary each week until Christmas. Can you record your thoughts and feelings about what's happened throughout the term?

(Pupils may want to wait until 14th Nov when they have finished learning about dairies in class)

Geography – Winnersh and Milan

Research the most famous landmarks in Milan (e.g. Duomo di Milano).

Make a poster including pictures of the landmarks and information about them. What are they used for? When were they built?

Why might Winnersh not have famous landmarks like Milan?

Science - Biology: Nutrition, Skeleton and Muscles

Draw (or stick in!) and annotate a diagram of a human skeleton. Can you identify the main and most important bones in the body?
