EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES / AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

Please find detailed below the Extra Curricular Activities we are offering for the Spring Term.

To secure a place in each club you will need to log on to your Arbor account and pay in advance for your child's place. If payment is not made your place cannot be confirmed.

Places are available on a first come first served basis and once the maximum pupil number has been reached you will no longer be able to register. In the past we have had many pupils sign up for clubs and then drop out at the beginning of each term. This system enables us to better prepare and only run clubs that are cost effective. The closing date to book each club will be **Friday 13th December**. Bookings will be accepted after this date if there are spaces left on a club. However, if we have insufficient numbers on Monday 16th December we may have to cancel the club. We will of course refund you immediately.
