What could he see? What could he smell? How did he spend his free time?</p> <p>Remember an exciting story involves a climax point where the character has to make a very tricky decision!</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p><u>'Highest and Lowest'</u></p> <p>Put operations signs (+ or – or × or ÷) between the numbers 3, 4, 5, 6 to make the highest possible number and lowest possible number.</p> <p>How about trying with numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6?</p> 
<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Read a playscript with a grown up and learn about how the language and structure differs from a narrative story.</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Research about the ancient Egyptian gods and choose one or two to draw and describe in a fact file.
