- Learn your 2, 5 and 10 times tables (TTRS) and know them in and out of order. Can you recall their division facts? Keep practising your number facts to 10 and 20.
- Complete your set Mathematics task.
- Practice spelling the Year 2 Common Exception Words in your neatest handwriting and on Spelling Shed.

Choose some activities to complete at home to help with your learning about our topic this half term.

Write sentences comparing our school today to what school life was like in the past. Ask members of your family what school was like for them. See if they have any photos of them from school.	When you have learnt all the facts, tell your family about the Walter Family and the impact they had on Sindlesham	Can you make a model/draw a building from the original Sindlesham model village? You can use homemade playdough, recycled materials like water bottles/cereal boxes and paper.
Plant some bulbs in your garden in preparation for Spring!	In Science, you will be learning about materials. Look around your house, what materials can you find?
