PE Uniform Reminder



The governors agreed that we would trial allowing children to come to school dressed in their PE kits on PE days. This will be reviewed at the end of this term. It is really important that children are dressed in the correct PE uniform. The correct PE uniform is:

- Gold school PE t-shirt with navy logo
- Plain navy shorts or jogging bottoms or track suit - no logos
- Plain navy sweatshirt (no hoodies) or printed school sweatshirt or cardigan with gold school logo
- All black trainers - including the soles.

The reason why we are asking for plain navy shorts, sweatshirts or jogging bottoms is so they blend with the school PE t-shirt logo. Because the children are wearing their PE kits all day, it is important that they still look smart. Thank you for your support in ensuring your child is dressed in the correct uniform.

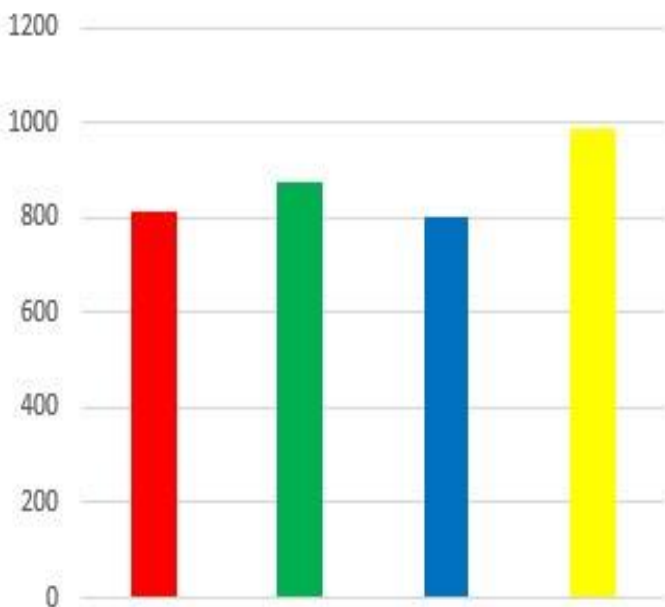

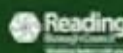
