<p><u>English – Non-chronological reports</u> Write a non-chronological report on your favourite animal (include introduction, subheadings, and fun facts).</p>	<p><u>History – Benin: An African Kingdom</u> Make a short presentation or poster about daily life in Benin (food, houses, jobs).</p>	<p><u>Art – Abstract drawings</u> Create an abstract drawing using only straight shapes and lines. Colour it in bold colours.</p> 
<p><u>English – Descriptions</u> Write a description of this character. Who is he? What does he carry and why? What is his story?</p> 	<p><u>History – Benin: An African Kingdom</u> Imagine you are an explorer visiting Benin for the first time — write a letter home describing what you saw.</p> 	<p><u>Art – Abstract drawings</u> Make an abstract collage from cut-out shapes, magazine scraps, or coloured paper.</p>
