We have had a fantastic week. Our Year One children went on a walk of the local area, looking at the natural environment. We are very lucky to have such lovely natural areas which our Year One children will be able to observe change with the seasons.

At the end of the summer term, we were able to share our excellent Year Six SATs results with you. We have now received information which compares us to all the schools in Wokingham. Our results were above the Wokingham average. For reading, our progress data was the sixth highest of the 45 Wokingham schools. The gap between our children in receipt of Pupil Premium and the rest is significantly smaller than the Wokingham average. This is all such fantastic news. It demonstrates the phenomenal progress we have made in recent years. But it doesn't stop there. We are on a mission to make Bearwood absolutely the best it possibly can be the sky is our limit!








#### **Change of Date**
