Like the End of Key Stage 1 tests, we will make the process as stress-free as possible. The children actually enjoy taking part in the screening check, especially reading the alien words!

As the summer is approaching please can you send your child in with a named hat and water bottle. On hot days we operate a 'no hat, no play' policy to ensure the safety of your child. If you wish to use sunscreen, please apply this on your child in the morning before you send them into school.
