Optional homework tasks - choose some activities to complete in your homework exercise book:

English

Write a story about a boy or a girl travelling back to the Stone Age and living in a dark cave. Remember the story must have a clear beginning, middle and end and should descriptive and interesting words for the reader.

Maths

'Highest and Lowest'

Put operations signs (+ or - or \times or \div) between the numbers 3, 4, 5, 6 to make the highest possible number and lowest possible number.

How about trying with numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6?



English

Create a haiku about the start of Autumn including the changes to the weather and the colour of the leaves.

Remember, a haiku has three lines. There can be any number of words, but there must be 5 syllables in the first line, 7 syllables in the second line and 5 syllables in the third line. They do not usually rhyme.

History

Find out about what food people in the Stone Age ate. What did they have to do to find their food? How did they prepare and cook it?

Design a Stone Age menu including a starter, main course and dessert.

<u>History</u>

Can you use different junk modelling materials at home to create a Stone Age weapon such as:

- A sword
- An axe
- A spear
- A hammerstone

PSHE

Friendship tribute

Make a poem, rap or song about friendship that:

- says why friendship is important
- includes some of the qualities of a friend



<u>Science</u>

How are extrusive igneous rocks formed? 'Chocolate' igneous rock!

- 1. Mix together 340g of chocolate chips with 150ml of coconut oil by heating it until the mixture is smooth (supervised by an adult)
- 2. Then, pour the mixture over an ice cube. The chocolate sauce will set hard like igneous rock specifically obsidian as the hot chocolate sauce touches the cold ice.
