If you have a concern

There will be times when as a parent, you have a concern about something at school. Please do follow these steps if this is the case:

<u>Step One:</u> Speak to the class teacher at the end of the school day. If you cannot do this, then you can phone the school office and leave a message, or send an email to the class teacher via the school office.

<u>Step Two:</u> If after communicating with the class teacher, you are still concerned, you should speak to the Team Leader for your child's phase. The Team Leaders for each phase are as follows:

- EYFS Mrs Johnson
- KS1 Mrs Haden
- LKS2 Miss Parry
- UKS2 Ms Alder

If you do not see the Team Leader in the playground, you can contact them via the school office.

<u>Step Three:</u> If after speaking with the Team Leader you are still concerned, then you can speak with Ms Alder, Headteacher.

<u>Step Four:</u> If after speaking to Ms Alder, you continue to be concerned, then you should ask the office for a copy of our complaints procedure. If you decide to make a complaint, you would put this in writing to Christine Jeater, Chair of Governors.

It is important to follow these steps, so that concerns can be rectified as early as possible. If you go straight to the headteacher, you may find that your concern takes longer to be addressed. We want to ensure we can help our parents as swiftly as possible. Thank you in advance for your cooperation with this.

World Mental Health Day



On Tuesday 10th October it was World Mental Health Day and in classes, we talked about why our mental health is so important and how we can make sure that we look after it. In our SMSC assembly this week, we listened to Ant and Dec. working with ITV's Britain Get Talking and the mental health charity 'Young Minds', explain the importance of talking to someone and sharing worries. They introduced a very special homework task: a conversation starter for children to take home, designed to help them talk about the hardest subjects on their minds with their parents, guardians or trusted adults. They know that sharing worries can help ease stress and reduce anxiety. Along with this week's newsletter, you will find the homework task to complete with your child, which is simply just to talk!


