

Applications must be submitted by 15 January. We spend a lot of time calling parents that have not called in to report an absence. Please ensure you report an absence before 9am.



Some of your Reception children may have started to take a book home to read to their parent/carer(s) at home.

Some parents/carers don't find this task easy and are not quite sure:

- how to get the most out of these sessions.
- how to help their child when they get stuck.
- why you are asking their child to re-read a text and how they can make that interesting and enjoyable.
 - what sorts of questions they should ask their child before/after they read.

That's why I'm running a 1-hour online workshop for parents/carers next Wednesday evening from 8-9pm during which we will look at simple texts which contain no more than one to two sentences on a page and consider how they might best structure a session in which their child reads aloud to them at home. We will consider the different approaches that they might take with an unseen text and one their child has previously read at school.


